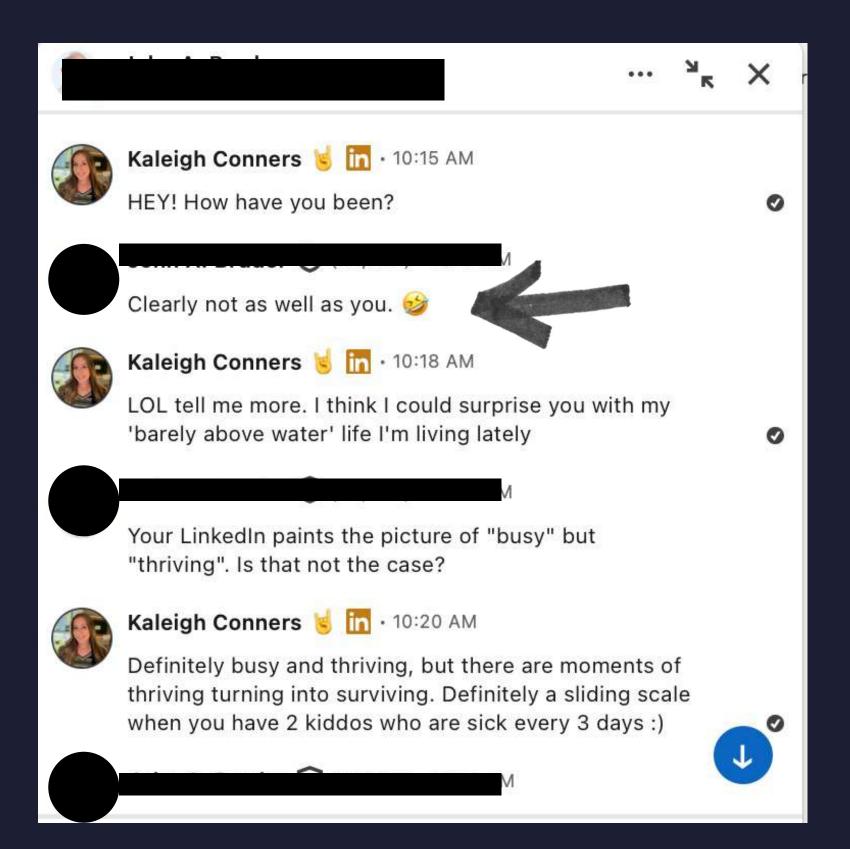

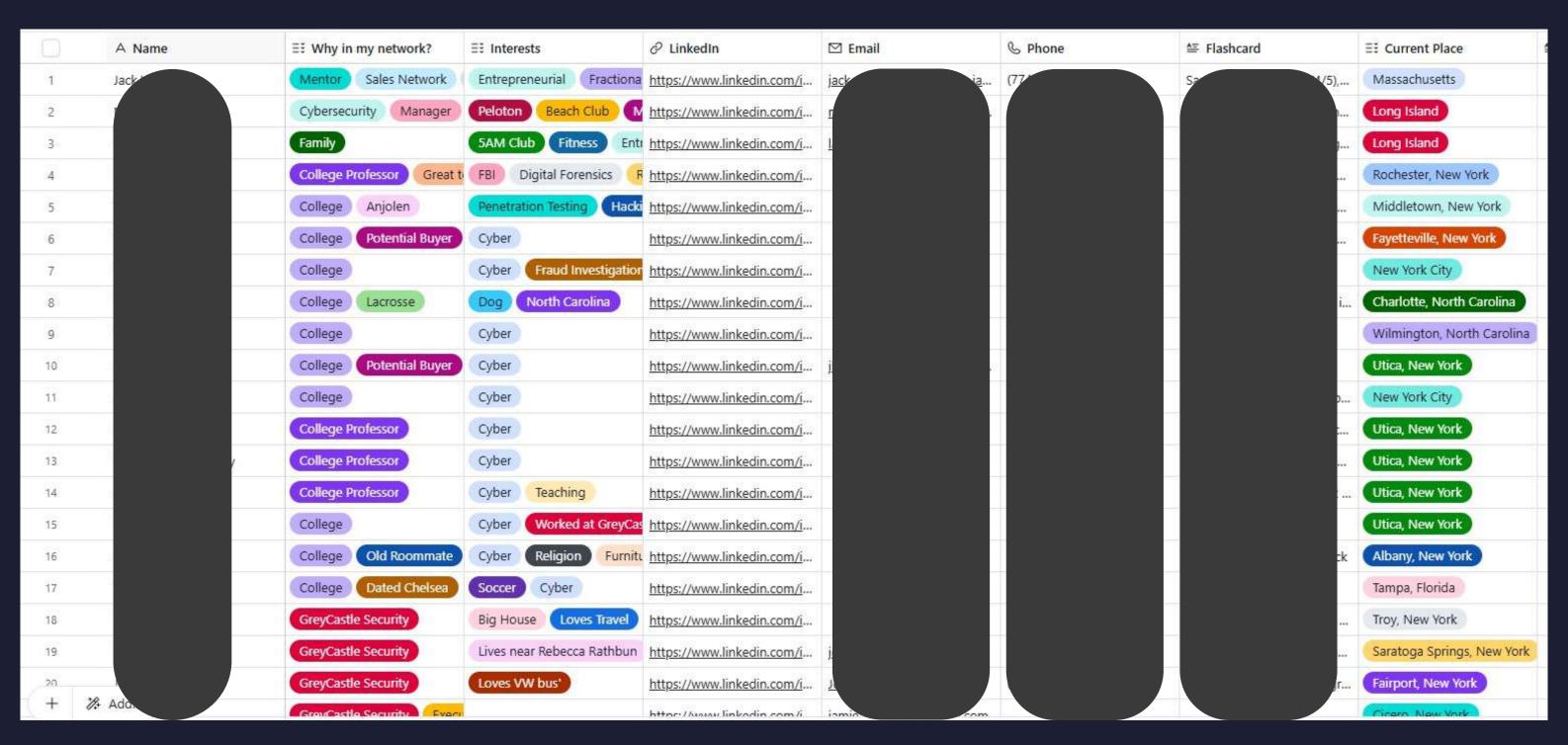

earnings: one person is making \$1M /year. Multiple other reps are making big \$\$. Ratio is stellar. Indicates a path exists for BIG earnings.

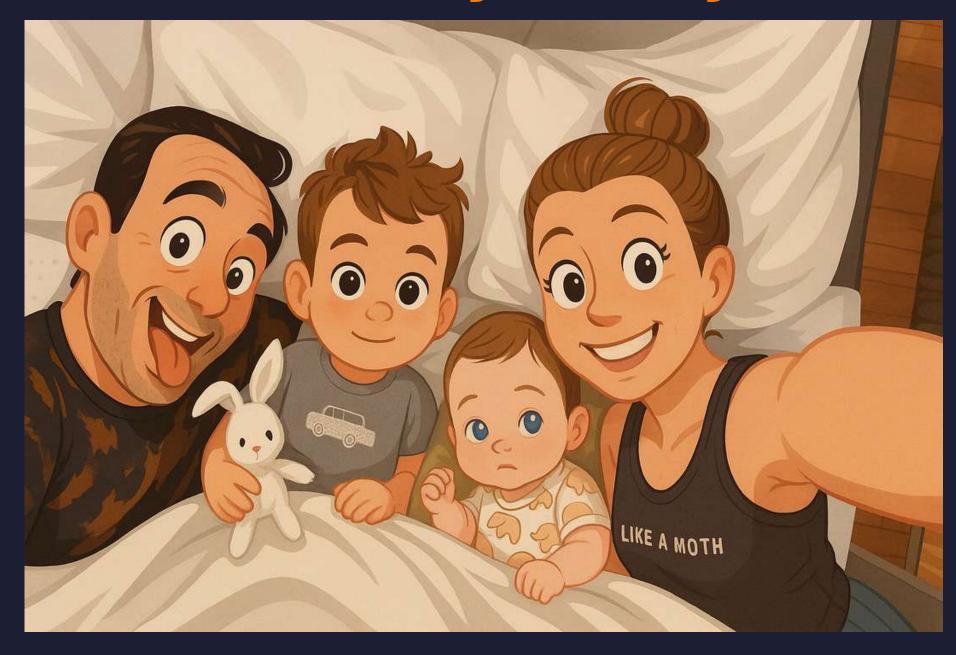


growth: most delivery + sales reps have been here for a while and have been promoted into different roles throughout time.

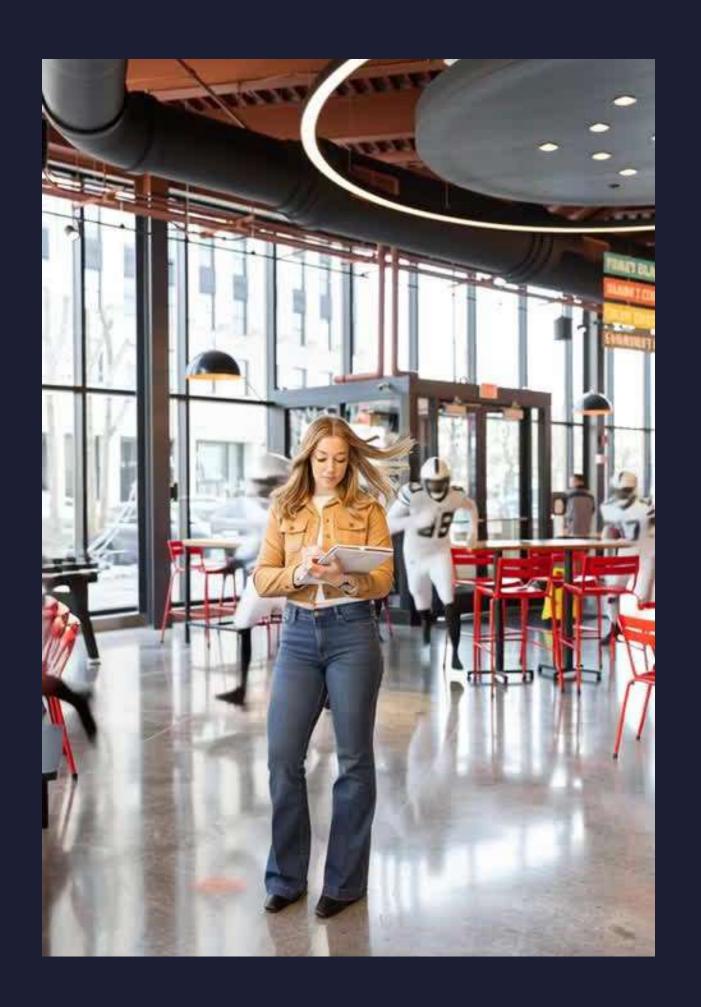
